



Investment changes

ORACLE SUPERANNUATION PLAN

In January 2015, some minor changes were made to the way the Plan's Growth option is invested.

The Trustee, in consultation with its investment consultant, has decided to increase the amount invested in real return funds and reduce the amount invested in global listed property. This was considered to be appropriate in the current investment climate. The change does not affect the investment objectives for the Growth option. There are no changes to any other options.

- Real return funds increased from 5% to 7.5%
- Global listed property (Hedged) decreased from 7.5% to 5%

There were also some changes to the Plan's investment managers.

- Property manager, Ironbark Asset Management (RREEF Global Property Securities Fund) was replaced by Resolution Capital (Global Property Securities Fund)
- International fixed interest manager, PIMCO (Global Credit Fund) was replaced by BlackRock Investment Management (Australia) Limited (Global Bond Index Fund).
